If this does not work, please download and print the form and complete by hand. Payment instructions are provided on the form. Forms should be completed by 11<sup>th</sup> April.

Hotel arrangements: Guildford Harbour Hotel - address: 3 Alexandra Terrace, Guildford GU1 3DA

**Hotel booking:** A block of rooms has been reserved for members at a fixed price (including breakfast) of £169 for a double room with 2 adults and £160 for a double room with one adult. The majority of the hotel rooms are doubles (one large bed). If you require 2 single beds (a twin room) please book early to be more sure of availability. To book please call 01483 792300 Option 1 and use booking reference 2405FBUAGR and provide your card details. Rooms can be cancelled up to 72 hours before with no charge, after that your reservation will be 100% chargeable.

These rooms will only be available at this price until 8 weeks before the event which means booking before the 14<sup>th</sup> March to secure the agreed price. After the 8 weeks, any unreserved rooms will be released and any bedrooms booked after that date will be subject to availability and the price will be determined by the hotel according to demand.

A small amount of accommodation is also available at the Angel Hotel, a 17C coaching Inn in the main street, a short walk away from the Harbour Hotel. Alternatively, rooms may be available at the Guildford Premier Inn and Guildford Travelodge but it should be noted that these are both located some distance from the town centre and a taxi ride away from the Harbour Hotel. Guesthouses and Air B n Bs are also available - please use the internet to make your own arrangements.

#### **Travel arrangements:**

Arriving Guildford: either

<u>By Train from Paris</u>: Eurostar from Gare du Nord to St Pancras International – then tube to Vauxhall or Waterloo and train to London Road, Guildford – approx. 1 hour journey time from Waterloo or Vauxhall, then a 10 minute walk to the hotel. If you arrive at the main Guildford Station, the hotel is a short taxi ride or 20 min walk.

By Air: From Paris to London Heathrow or Gatwick (Air France, BA, Easyjet & Vueling). From Heathrow, tube to Waterloo then by train as above. From Gatwick either frequent Southern trains to Clapham junction changing to a SWR train to London Road (Guildford) – 1.5 hour total journey time from Gatwick via Clapham Junction to London Rd, Guildford then a 10 minute walk. Or there is an hourly GWR Reading service direct to the main Guildford Station via Redhill – 45min journey time plus taxi ride or 20 min walk to the hotel.
